



Effective Social Work Practice in Adult Services: A **Core** Curriculum

This six-day event is designed to help DSS adult services social workers integrate the concepts of *A Model for Excellence in Adult Services Administration and Social Work Practice* into their practice: family-centered social work, empowerment of adults and their families, and the importance of cultural differences. Participants practice basic skills in counseling, functional assessment, helping adults and families set goals, emergency and crisis intervention, and service planning and monitoring.
