

## Accessing On-line Courses Via Sakai

To access the online course, **Brief History of Oppression and Resistance (SOWO999\_ALLSUII09)**, log on to the Internet and go to <https://sakaipilot.unc.edu/xsl-portal>

Log in using your UNC Onyen and password. This step opens the **My Workspace** page. Make sure you have given Linda Wilson (at [ltw2517@email.unc.edu](mailto:ltw2517@email.unc.edu)) your ONYEN so you can be enrolled in this course.

In the upper right corner of the My Workspace page, locate and click on the **My Sites** tab. From the drop-down menu of courses, click on **SOWO999\_ALLSUII09**, which will open the course page.

To access the on-line course materials, locate the **Course Tools** box on the left sidebar of the page and click on **Lessons**. You will be presented with links to all of the learning objectives, reading material, films, podcasts that correspond to each course module.

We'll explore each media type.

Clicking on an **Overview** link will take you to an animated presentation that serves as a guide to the topics covered in each section. The image you see on the Overview screen is fully interactive and contains video clips, slideshows, links to related Web sites, and a bibliography.

Clicking a **Reading** link will open a PDF file, which requires that you have a PDF reader (e.g., Adobe Reader) installed on your computer. Once the file has downloaded and opened, you can read the material or save a copy to your computer.

Clicking a **Web site** link will take you to the relevant Web site, which you can then fully explore.

The **Film** link takes you to a compressed video on a relevant topic.

The last media type is the podcast. Clicking on the **Podcast** link will open a page that provides an RSS feed address to iTunes University. Highlight the link, right-click and select Copy from the drop-down menu, and paste the link into iTunes. iTunes will then begin downloading the videos in this podcast.
