1. Library Help and Research Consultations

Your subject librarian is available to meet with you to discuss your research and to answer any library-related questions you have. Angela Bardeen is the Social Work Librarian. She can suggest sources of information and assist with search strategies. You can email her bardeen@email.unc.edu to schedule an appointment. You can also set up an appointment with Angela to learn how to use the bibliographic management software RefWorks. 2. Borrowing and renewing books and other library materials

Your One Card is your library card. Different libraries on campus have different loan periods based on their collections and the needs of users. 3. Interlibrary Borrowing and Document Delivery

Also, your UNC One Card enables you to borrow materials from Duke and North Carolina State University libraries when you visit those libraries or through our shared catalog at <http://search.trln.org/>. Carolina BLU is a delivery service for books from UNC, Duke, and NC State.

4. Social Work Databases

Major Social Work databases can be found by clicking the E-Research Tools link on the main library page (www.lib.unc.edu) and then selecting "Social Work" under the "By Subject" option <http://eresources.lib.unc.edu/eid/subject.php?subjectName=Social+Work>.
