



CREATING TRANS-AFFIRMING SOCIAL WORK FIELD PLACEMENTS

Creating Trans-Affirming Social Work Field Placements is a **two-part online course** developed for social work students, field instructors and agency staff. Participants may take either or both modules and will receive a certificate for one contact hour of continuing education credits for each part that is completed. The training is free and delivered in an online asynchronous format for social work students and faculty, field instructors and agencies.

PART I: TRANS IDENTITY 101

The participant will explain the key concepts of gender identity, gender pronoun usage and intersecting identities and be able to describe ethical issues to consider when supporting trans people.

PART II: WORKING WITH TRANS IDENTIFIED SOCIAL WORK STUDENT INTERNS

The participant will consider the key components of preparing to supervise trans identified student interns including opportunities to be a supervisory trans ally, best practices to provide supervision to trans identified student interns and suggestions for potential agency stumbling blocks and how to overcome them.
