Family and Children's Resource Program (FCRP)

This program, through its partnership with the N.C. Division of Social Services, develops and delivers online and classroom-based in-service training courses for child welfare professionals. Training topics include but are not limited to attachment, coaching, substance use, child mental health issues, and family time/visitation. FCRP also provides group facilitation, design and conducts readiness assessments, supports the implementation of practice improvement and change efforts, and develops and maintains [a website](#) the state division's learning management system, which grants public and private child welfare professionals access to training.
